## Note from the Composers

With references to explorers who braved the unknown and discovered new lands and countries, this piece highlights how critical it is for each of us to believe in our own abilities and reach for our own goals. The text of this piece may help you and your listener to understand that even when negative words or actions are directed our way, we have the capacity to move past those obstacles and accomplish great things.

Bullying is a prevalent concern in most schools, and this song's message is meant to reiterate the tremendous value each student's life possesses. In the face of trials and setbacks, there must be willingness to believe in oneself and to develop and refine individual talents, skills and potential, so we can embrace the promise of a bright future.

The music moves along pretty quickly, so sing this with determination and a smile. When you get to the chorus in m. 20, exude positivity and assurance! "There is more beyond where the sky meets the sea ..." – what a beautiful sentiment! We can choose to overcome our fear, and press on into the unknown. At m. 41 where the second chorus begins, these words are very important so be certain your pronunciation is clear. Everyone knows the sting of teasing, bullying, and negativity. Mean it when you say "I'm determined to be a positive force."

As you approach the final chorus in measure 82, sing with controlled volume so you still have room for a crescendo to fortissimo at the end. The last two words may be spoken or sung, depending on your conductor's preference.

We hope you enjoy this song and are encouraged to be a "brave achiever" long after the concert is over!
